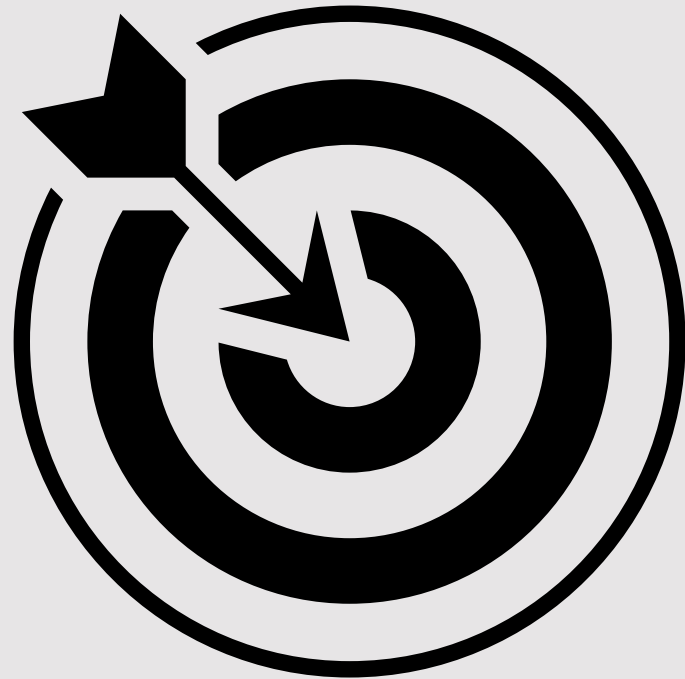

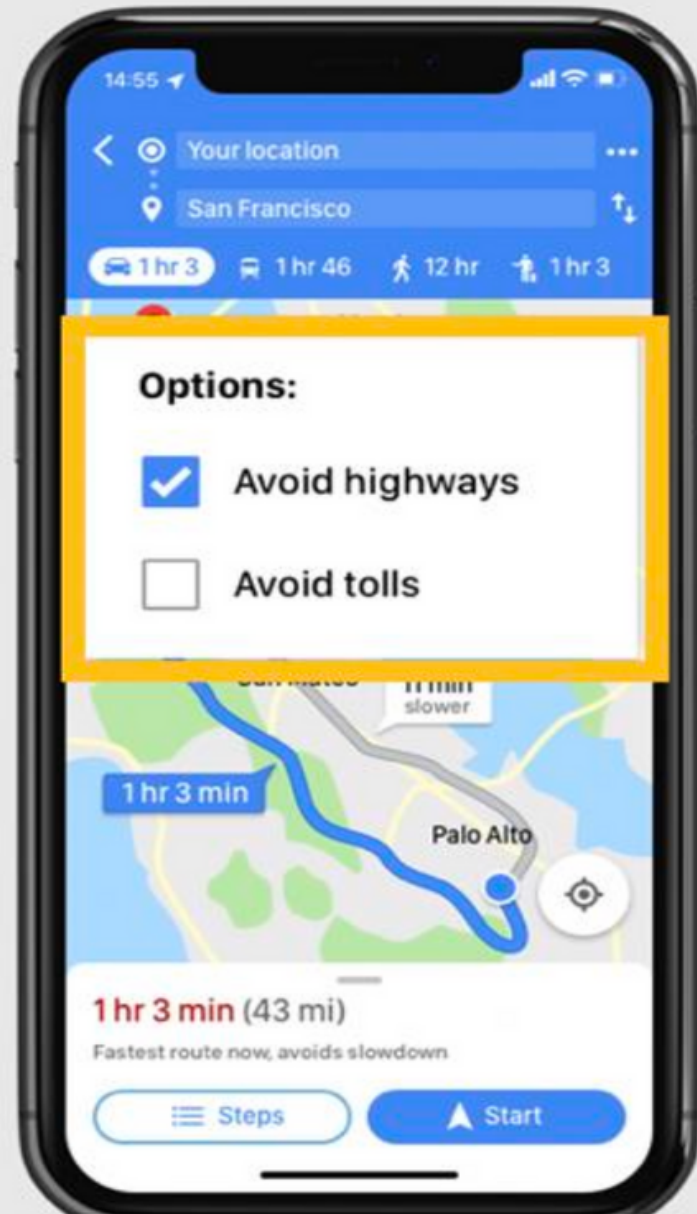

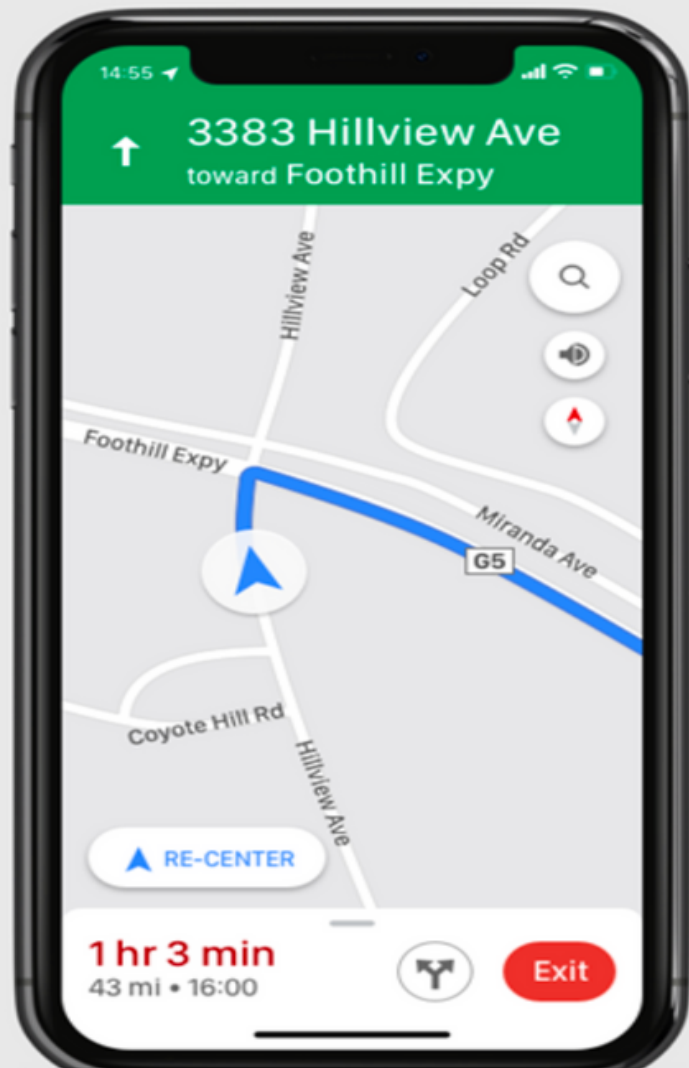

- What would be the impact on completion of running half/twice as many sections of a course?
- What if we canceled half the classes that meet a given requirement?
- If we must cut classes, which ones do we absolutely need to keep to make sure seniors graduate on time?

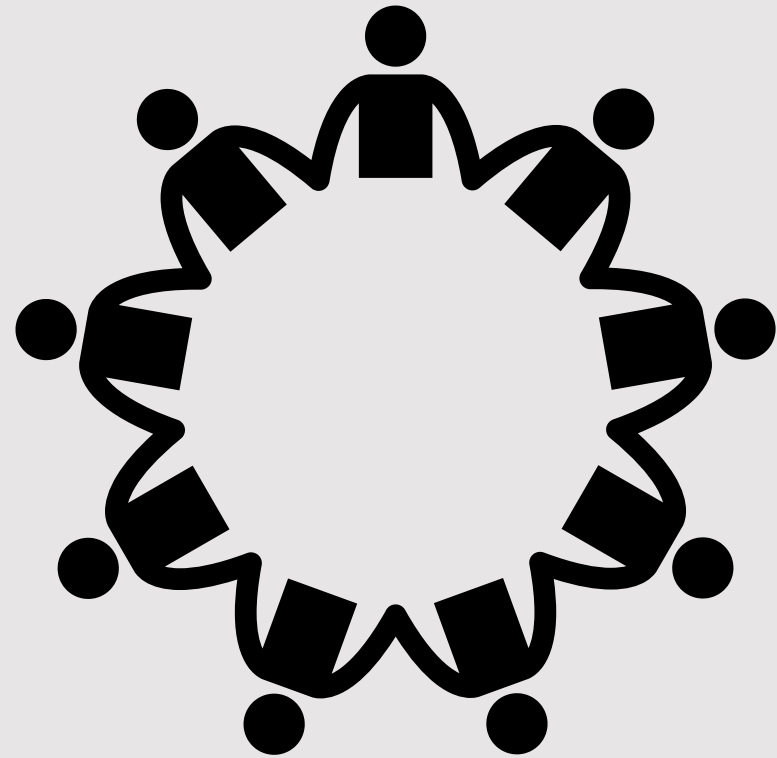
