NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATION

DATE: May 26, 2006

REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE: Student Affairs

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Counseling Services (2.006)

SUMMARY OF REGULATION: The amended Regulation provides that counseling services are available at the University to all enrolled students; all services are confidential to the extent required by law; records are available to persons designated in writing by the student and records will be maintained for seven years after student reaches age of 18. In addition, the Regulation limits counseling services to 12 individual sessions a semester and provides referral to community agencies for students needing more intensive services.

AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION: Article IX, Florida Constitution, Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure dated July 21, 2005 and Section 1001.74(10), Florida Statutes.
