

Reporting Student Conduct Violations

In emergency situations, when there are immediate concerns about the safety or health of a student or others, call **9-1-1** for immediate assistance and follow up by submitting a report.

In non-emergency situations, please consult with your program director, or the Office of Student Conduct prior to submitting a report if you have any concerns or uncertainties.

Any person with knowledge may submit a written report to the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution

How to Report a Conduct Issue

1. Submit an online report

2. Email the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution

Include: your name, contact info, detailed description of incident, and any evidence.

3. Visit the office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution

After submission:

1. The report is reviewed by Student Conduct staff.
2. An investigation may be initiated.
3. If warranted, a conduct hearing is scheduled.
4. Appropriate sanctions or resolutions are implemented.

Examples of Violations:

- Academic Dishonesty (cheating, plagiarism)
- Disruptive or Disorderly Behavior
- Harassment
- Alcohol/Drug Violations
- Property Damage or Theft
- Providing False Information and/or Falsification of University Records
