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

POST AWARD

Office of Sponsored Programs

- Review and Negotiate the Budget
- Set-up the Project Account
- Email the PI the Award Package

Coordinators Roles

- Approve and manage expenditures of Requisitions, Employment and Travel
- Assist with Budget Modification and no-cost extensions.

Principal Investigator (PI) Roles

- Meet with Dept. Rep.
- Review the Budget and Proposed Expenditures
- Submit reports

Department Representatives

- Enter Requisitions, Employment Package, Travel Authorization, and Expense Reports for Sponsored Program coordinator approval

NEXT STEPS

- OSP Coordinator will contact each PI to review budget justification for compliance.
- PI will receive an Award Package to inform them of the project number, chart field information and project end date.
- PIs may be required to submit budget revisions, if necessary
