COMPETITION CRITERIA

- 1 ELIGIBILITY:** FAMU undergraduate students with at least a 2.5 GPA who have completed ENC 1101 with a “C” or higher
- 2 APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE** a copy of a FAMU unofficial transcript, the student’s signature, and a letter of recommendation on official letterhead from the faculty member that taught a writing enhanced class for which the student was/is enrolled.
- 3 SUBMISSION** (via Blackboard in APA Format (Click [here](#) for APA Format).

Writing Guidelines:

In a narrative format with a minimum of 3,000 words and no more than 5,000 words, the student will complete a reflection of writing assignment. In the narrative, the student should include:

- 1) The skills that were used in completing the assignment (language, grammar, punctuation, spelling, sentence structure, cohesiveness, etc)
- 2) What writing skills need to be strengthened and how with the student go about strengthening these skills)
- 3) Why the student feels these skills are important and how will they use them in their current educational and future career endeavors.
- 4) Identify the various ways written communication is demonstrated in the work-place.
- 5) If you could change anything about your previous writing experience and performance, what would you change?
