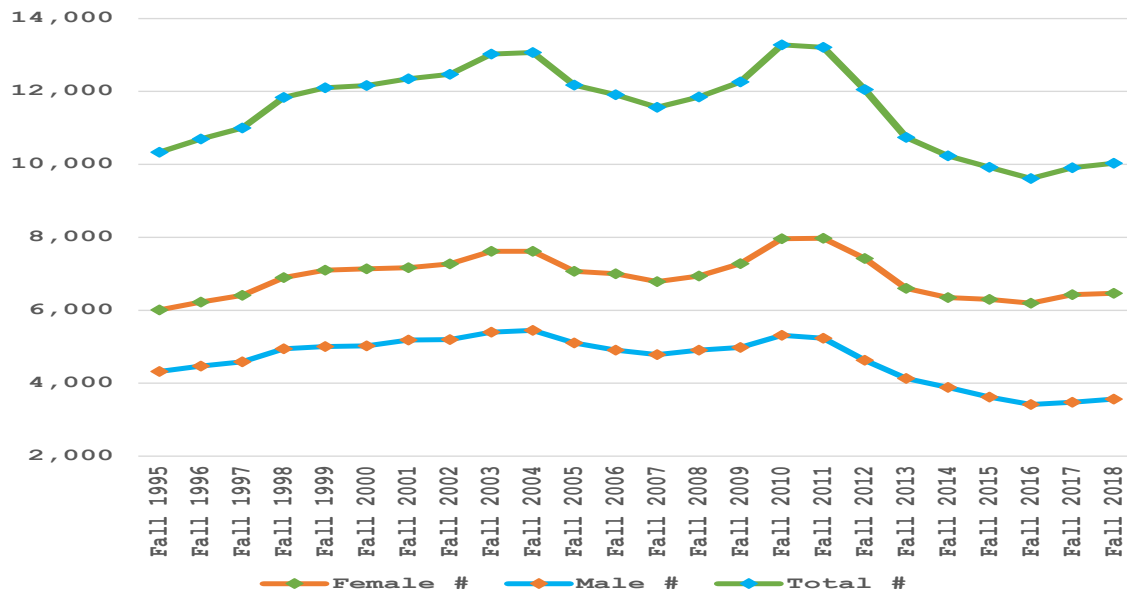

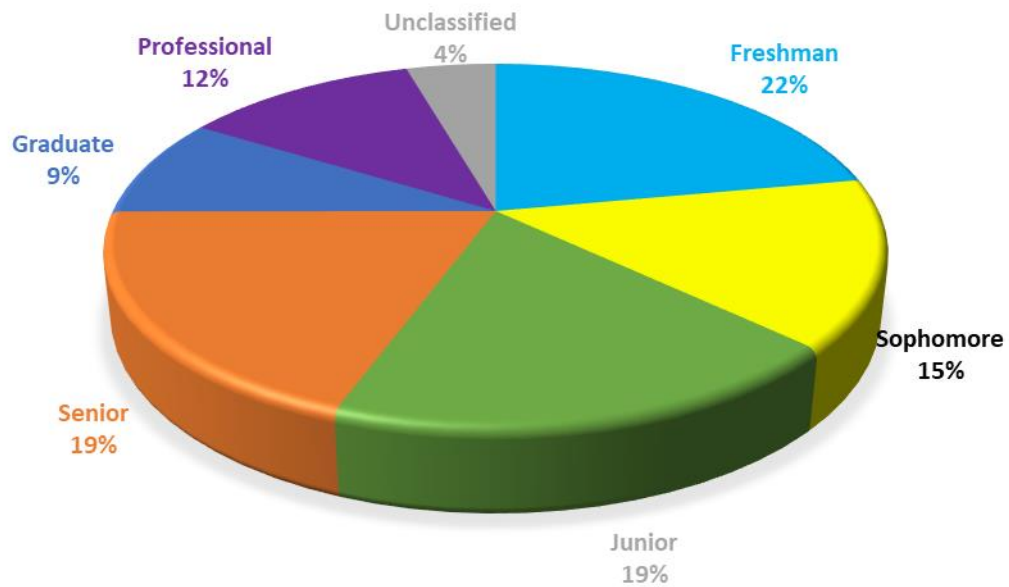

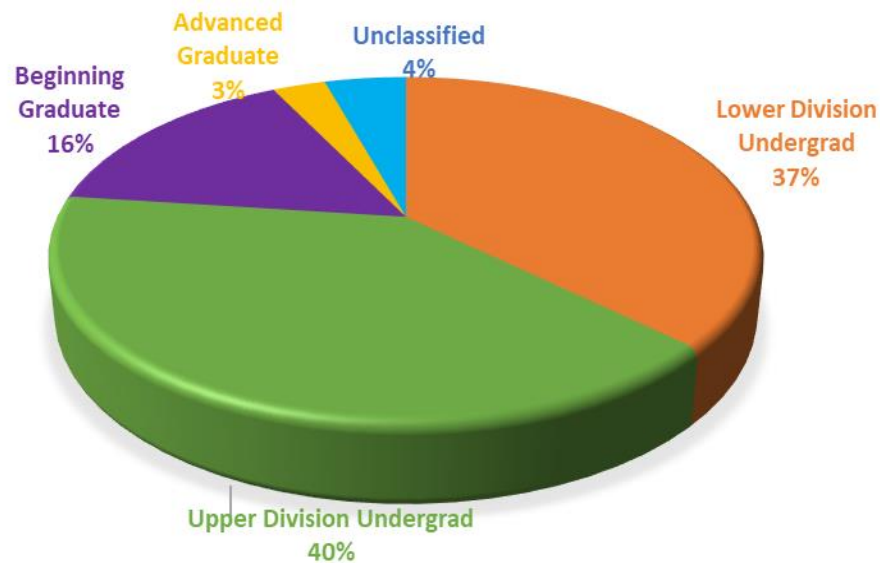
Student Enrollment by Institutional Classification Fall 2018

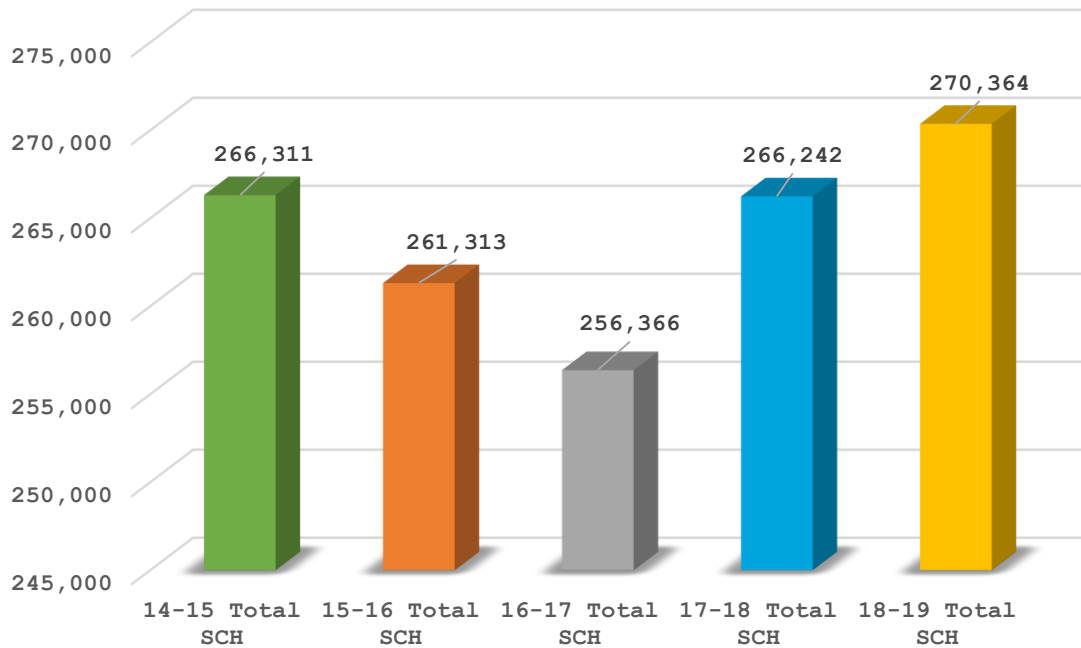

Full-time vs. Part-time Students by School/College, by Level Fall 2018

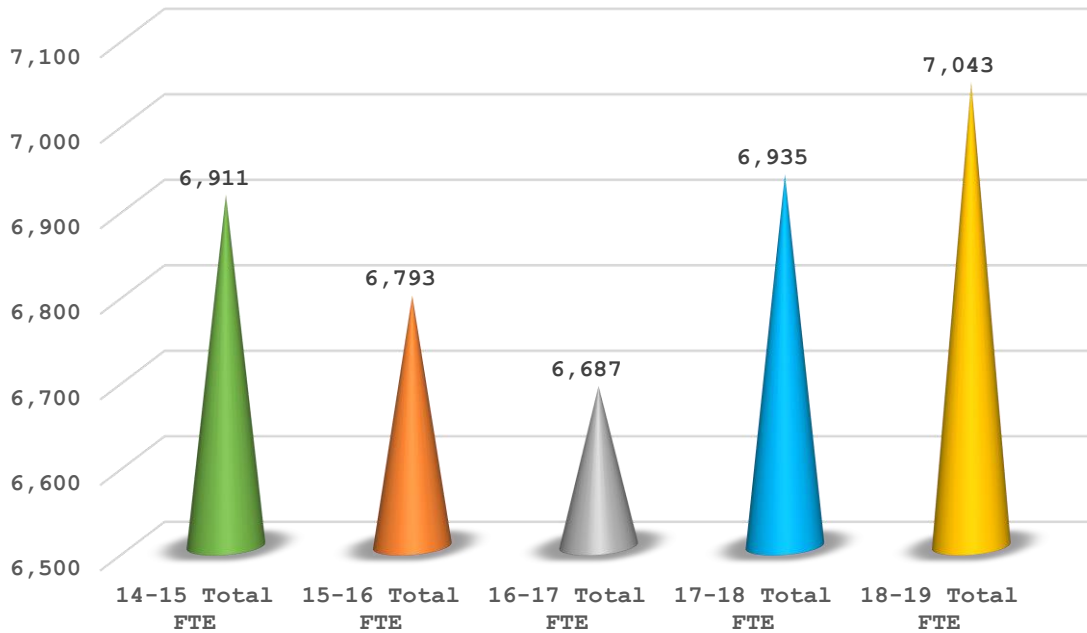
